Friday Evening

Welcome Mass:

Priests: Please bring amice, alb, and cincture (stole and chasuble provided)

Knights, Dames, and Investees: Business Casual*

Pilgrim/States Dinner:

All: Business Casual*

Saturday

Memorial Mass/Promotions:

Bishops: Please bring amice, alb, cincture and white mitre (stole and chasuble provided)

Priests: Please bring amice, alb, and cincture (stole and chasuble provided)

Promotees:

Priests: Please bring amice, alb, and cincture (stole and chasuble provided.)

Knights: Business Attire**, cape, beret, white gloves, neck insignia

Dames: Black dress, black hose, black shoes, cape, mantilla, black gloves, neck insignia

All Others: Business suits and dresses without capes, Rosettes only may be worn (no neck or miniature insignia)

Vigil Dinner and Reception:

All: Business attire**

Vigil at Arms Service - Mandatory for all Investees:

Bishops: Choir cassock, fascia, rochet, mozetta, zucchetto, biretta, pectoral cross

Priest investees: Cassock of the proper rank, surplice/rochet, and biretta (optional)

Other Priests: Cassock, surplice, mozetta, biretta (optional)

Knights, Dames, and Investees: Business Attire**

Sunday

Mass and Investiture Ceremony:

Bishops: Please bring amice, alb, cincture and white mitre (stole and chasuble provided)

Priests: Please bring amice, alb, and cincture (stole and chasuble provided)

Investees:

Priests: Cassock and surplice/rochet. Bring with you your mozetta, amice, alb, and cincture (stole and chasuble provided)

Knights: White Tie Tuxedo, cape folded neatly over left arm with cross showing, beret carried in left hand wearing white gloves (provided at investee meeting)

Dames: Black dress (below the knee), modest neckline, long or ¾ sleeve, black hose, black closed toed shoes, mantilla, cape folded neatly over left arm with cross showing

wearing black gloves (provided at investee meeting). If necessary to carry purse, keep on left arm under folded cape

All Others:

Knights: Business Attire**, cape and beret with neck insignia under cape wearing white gloves

Dames: Black dress, black shoes, cape and mantilla with neck insignia under cape wearing black gloves

Formal Reception and Banquet:

Bishops: House Cassock with decorations

Priests: Cassock with decorations (you may wear a suit if you don't have a cassock)

Knights: Formal (white tie) tuxedo with neck insignia (no capes or berets)

Dames: Formal eveningwear with neck insignia (no capes or mantillas)

Attendance restricted to members, spouses, companions, and pastors

Monday

Travelers' Mass:

Clergy: Appropriate Mass attire

Knights & Dames: Casual Dress***

***Business Casual:** Knights: slacks, open shirt; Ladies: blouse or sweater, slacks or dress (appropriate for Mass)

****Business Attire:** Knights: Dark Suit, White Shirt, Tie; Ladies: Black Dress, Black Hose, Black Shoes

*****Casual Dress:** Comfortable travel clothing (appropriate for Mass)
