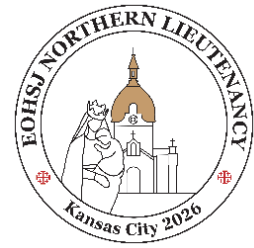


EOHSJ 2026 ANNUAL MEETING SPEAKERS INFORMATION



Father Paul Turner

Father Turner is pastor of the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Kansas City, MO, and director of the Office of Divine Worship for the Catholic Diocese of Kansas City-St Joseph. He holds a doctorate in Sacred Theology (STD) from Sant' Anselmo in Rome. He is a consultor for the Dicastery for Divine Worship and the Discipline of the Sacraments. He will discuss "How the Catholic Liturgy Celebrates Mary as the Mother of the Church."



Mike Scherschligt

The founder and executive director of the Holy Family School of Faith, Mike has a doctorate in Sacred Theology (STD) from the Marianum in Rome. Mike will be discussing "Fatima: The Interpretive Key to the Modern World — Medjugorje: The Completion and the Triumph of the Immaculate Heart."
